



Waiver of Rights to Free Interpretation Services

Under the law, New York State agencies that provide services or benefits to the public must offer interpretation services to the person receiving services or benefits in their primary language. If you self-identify or have been identified as an individual with limited English proficiency by the agency and wish to waive your right to free interpretation services, you need to complete this form. The information you share in this form will be kept private and will not be shared with any external parties.
