This is a response to the EQUAL grant proposal of the following:

1. FAST FLUSH / HIGH RISE TOILETS

Many times the public washrooms are held up because residents cannot use as quickly as they would like due to slow movement during its use. Fast flush allows the toilet to be used and quickly be ready for the next resident waiting anxiously (avoiding arguments, accidents of incontinence as well as toilet clogging). Due to a level of "memory loss" within the population causes the pipes to be plugged as the resident disposes of inappropriate waste products.

High rise toilet allows them secure sitting posture and avoids loss of balance even though there are balance bars in the bathroom. Less strain on the knees.

This is the reason we want to replace toilets with modern upgraded high efficiency toilets.

We met again with the resident council and made revisions to the original grant application (as you requested) to avoid any loss of funding. We eliminated what the previous application requested that was in question and took other possibilities for the residents enjoyment and participation
