Summary of Services (consistent language)	Assisted Living Residence (ALR) Amber Court of Westbury [The Alcove at Westbury] is a licensed adult home approved by the New York State Department of Health to operate as an Assisted Living Residence (ALR). The ALR provides housing, twenty-four-hour on-site monitoring, and personal care services and/or home care services in a home-like setting for five or more adult residents. The ALR provides housekeeping, laundry services, and three meals per day, as well as recreational activities. Residents receive a minimum of 3.75 hours of personal care services per day, as needed, medication management, and case management services. An individualized service plan (ISP) is developed, implemented, and reviewed based on assessed needs. Residents reside in private or shared rooms and have access to shared common areas. Services are provided in accordance with

the assisted living philosophy, emphasizing dignity, autonomy, independence, privacy, and choice.

Enhanced Assisted Living Residence (EALR)

Amber Court of Westbury [The Alcove at Westbury] is certified by the New York State Department of Health to operate as an Enhanced Assisted Living Residence (EALR). The EALR provides an enhanced level of care for individuals whose needs exceed those permitted in a Basic ALR.

Residents in the EALR may require assistance with transfers, ambulation, or stair use; assistance with medical equipment; and/or assistance with chronic urinary or bowel incontinence. Enhanced services support individuals with progressive or chronic conditions and allow residents to age in place, provided their needs can be safely met within the residence.

The EALR assures that residents' nursing and medical needs can be met through appropriate staffing, services, and care planning. Residents requiring continuous twenty-four-hour skilled nursing or medical care beyond the scope of the EALR are transferred to a nursing facility or hospital, unless all regulatory criteria for continued residence are met.

Special Needs Assisted Living Residence (SNALR)

Amber Court of Westbury – The Alcove at Westbury is certified by the New York State Department of Health to operate as a Special Needs Assisted Living Residence (SNALR) for individuals with Alzheimer's disease, dementia, or other cognitive impairments.

The SNALR provides specialized supervision, staffing, and programming designed to meet the needs of residents with cognitive impairment. Services include enhanced staff training, individualized care planning, structured daily routines, and environmental supports to promote resident safety, functioning, and quality of life.

Admission to the SNALR is based on assessment to ensure that the resident's needs can be appropriately met. Individualized service plans are developed and reviewed on an ongoing basis in accordance with regulatory requirements.

LEVEL 1 CARE - \$1900 Daily supervision or assistance with bathing, clothing selection/dressing, and grooming by an aide. Supervision and assistance under this care level is available twenty-four (24) hours a day. LEVEL 2 CARE - \$2100 Daily supervision or assistance with bathing, clothing selection/dressing, and grooming by an aide. Includes interment supervision and/or assistance with any of the following: transferring, ambulating, and mobility with or without assistive device. Supervision and assistance under this care level is available twenty-four (24) hours a day. LEVEL 3 CARE - \$2400 Daily supervision and/or assistance with bathing, clothing selection/dressing, and grooming by aides. Includes interment supervision and/or assistance with any of the following: eating, transferring, ambulation, and mobility with or without assistive devices. Requires assistance with toileting every 2-4 hours by an aide to maintain continence and skin integrity (this care level is geared toward people that have managed incontinence). Supervision and assistance under this care level is interspersed throughout a twenty-four (24) hour timeframe daily. LEVEL 4 CARE - \$2800 Daily supervision and/or assistance with bathing, clothing selection/dressing, and grooming by aides. Includes chronic assistance with any of the following: eating, transferring (with or without a mechanical device), ambulation, and mobility with assistive devices. Requires assistance with incontinence care every 2-4 hours by an aide to maintain skin integrity (this care level is geared toward people that have unmanaged incontinence). Supervision and assistance under this care level is interspersed throughout a twenty-four (24) hour timeframe daily.
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
