Dear Administrator:

This letter provides information about your Personal Care and/or Consumer Directed Medicaid reimbursement rates effective October 1, 2022. The State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2022-23 Enacted Budget provided for a Minimum Wage increase for home care aides of two dollars effective October 1, 2022.

Effective October 1, 2022, the Minimum Wage rate adjustment for Home Care Aides increased by \$2 plus an adjustment for corresponding Fringe Benefits.

The provider-specific rates have been posted for your information at https://www.health.ny.gov/facilities/long_term_care/reimbursement/cdpap/ and https://www.health.ny.gov/facilities/long_term_care/reimbursement/pcr/.

The payment for the October 1, 2022, rates to effectuate the Minimum Wage increase will be made in Cycle 2356 with a Check Date of October 24, 2022, and a Check Release Date of November 9, 2022.
