## Who?

## What?

Strategic and collaborative planning to develop the State Health Improvement Plan (SHIP) and Community Health Improvement Plans (CHIP).

## Where?

State-wide and community-level plans with implementation from state to local levels.

## When?

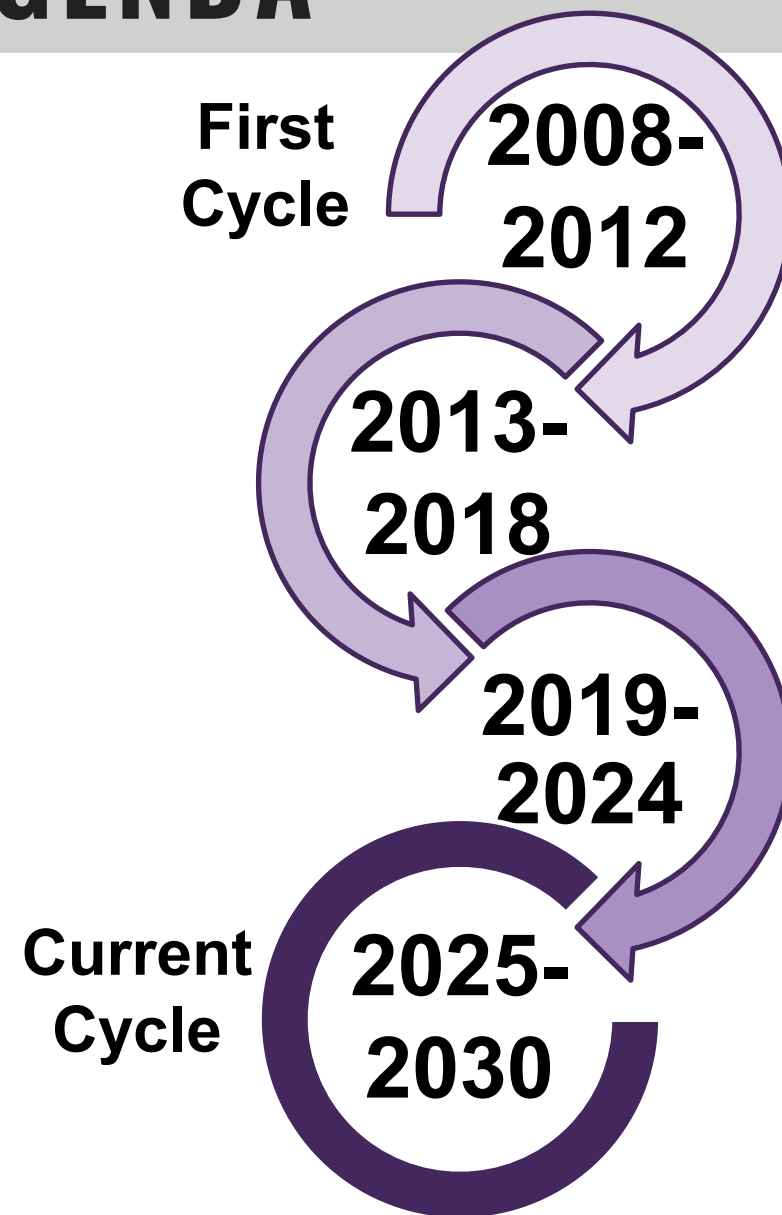
A new cycle starts every 6 years

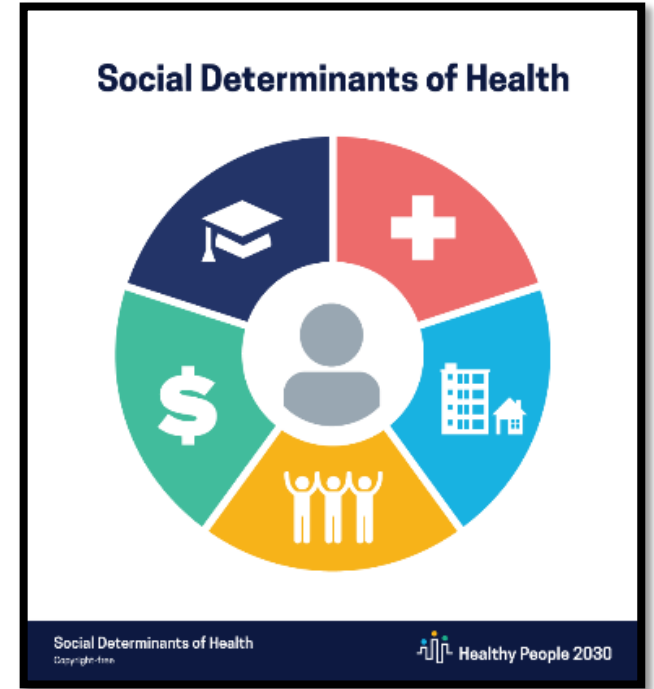
