The following are official modifications, which are hereby incorporated into IFB# C041190 Hunger Prevention and Nutrition Assistance Program Transportation Project. The information contained in this amendment prevails over the original IFB language. For all amendments below, deleted language appears in strikethrough ("~~xxx~~") and added language appears in underline ("xxx").

4. DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

The Transportation Project contract is designed to increase the variety, quantity and quality of food available to persons in need of food assistance in NYS. Using cost effective strategies this project funds the transport of HPNAP nutritionally eligible purchased and donated foods from throughout the nation to HPNAP supported regional food banks in NYS. These regional food banks then distribute the food to EFPs. Annually, this project, has funded the transport of as much as 10.5 million pounds of food from across the nation to NYS regional food banks. The Transportation Project contract is designed to accommodate HPNAP nutrition ~~policies~~ policies, FA provisions, NYS regional food banks' food distribution procedures, and fluctuating funding levels for food transportation services.

HPNAP establishes the total contract amount for transporting food (the total of all lines of credit). This amount may fluctuate based on available funding. HPNAP may establish or can approve the contractor's recommendation for the individual lines of credit for each of the eight supported regional food banks from the total funds available for transporting food. The lines of credit pay the costs of moving food to and between regional food banks; these costs are billed to the contractor by food transportation companies.

4.1. Tasks/Deliverables

3. Establish a system to solicit bids from food transportation companies (carriers) on traffic lanes from shipper/donor's warehouse to one or more of the ~~eight~~ ten HPNAP supported regional food banks (RFB) or between RFBs.

4.2. Staffing Requirements

At least one full-time equivalent (FTE) position must be established to perform the task and deliverables listed above. A full-time equivalency (FTE) can be achieved through the use of one or more staff positions.
