

Attachment 5: Definitions

1. **Community water system:** A public water system which serves at least five service connections used by year-round residents or regularly serves at least 25 year-round residents.
2. **Service connection:** The pertinent pipes, valves, and fittings that connect a distribution system to a consumer's facility.
3. **Water fluoridation equipment:** The equipment required for the fluoride feed system (saturator, dry feed, or acid-based system), testing and analysis of fluoride, and/or personal operator safety when operating the fluoride feed system.
4. **Wholesale:** A public water system that treats source water as necessary to produce finished water and then delivers some or all of that finished water to another public water system. Delivery may be through a direct connection or through the distribution system of one or more consecutive systems.
