



Continuous Recruitment for the Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC) and the Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC)

Purpose

The Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC) and the Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC) will assist the New York State Medicaid program in providing access to the highest quality and cost-effective care to Medicaid members. Committee members will advise and inform policy development in matters related to the Medicaid and Children's Health Insurance Program ("Child Health Plus" or CHPlus) programs.

Membership

Participants of the MAC and BAC are appointed by the New York State Department of Health Commissioner. Completing the application is the first step toward becoming a committee member. Selected applicants will undergo a vetting process as part of the next phase

Medicaid Advisory Committee (MAC)

To serve the MAC, interested individuals must be New York state licensed clinical providers or administrators, state or local consumer advocacy groups or other community-based organizations, health plan representatives and state agencies serving Medicaid members, Committee members will serve a three-year term.

Beneficiary Advisory Council (BAC)

To serve the BAC, interested individuals must be current or previous Medicaid or CHPlus members or have direct experience supporting New York State Medicaid or CHPlus members, such as family members or caregivers. Committee members will serve a two-year term.

Application
