Criminal Justice Initiative

Intent: Provide HIV/STD/HCV prevention interventions and support services in DOCCS facilities as well as short-term transitional services. This initiative consists of 25 contracts with 13 agencies and is supported by State and CDC Funding.

Contracted In-facility Services:

Client Recruitment: outreach activities within correctional settings that are designed to engage and recruit inmates at high-risk for HIV/STI and hepatitis C and HIV-infected inmates into proposed program activities and services provided by DOCCS or other community-based organizations providing services within correctional facilities.

Prevention Interventions and Support: structured interventions and activities proven to be effective and that use evidence-based models and risk reduction strategies to build health protective skills, promote prevention behaviors, and support long-term behavior change for inmates. These interventions may be delivered by funded staff or by peers with the support/oversight of funded staff.

Peer Educator Training: activities to train incarcerated peers to provide HIV/AIDS, STI and hepatitis C related information to other inmates. Peer training services also include the provision of peer support, supervision and ongoing skills development for peer trainees.

Anonymous HIV Counseling and Testing, Referral and Partner Services: provision of anonymous HIV counseling and testing to inmates at high risk of HIV infection who are unaware of their status with a focus on identifying new cases. Confirmed cases must be referred and linked to medical care and partner services after converting anonymous test results to confidential.

Prison Hotline Services: a telephone hotline for the provision of information and referrals, support services and transitional planning to high risk and HIV infected individuals incarcerated in NYS correctional facilities.

Contracted Transitional Services:

Transitional Planning for HIV Positive Inmates: time limited/pre-release activities that are designed to connect HIV positive inmates with community based services and ensure a continuum of health care. The intent of this intervention is to establish referrals with health care providers, housing and other community based agencies the releasee will access upon release; services begin up to 6 months prior to release.

Community Services Coordination upon Release: coordination and implementation of community services as scheduled during the in-facility Transitional Planning process for HIV positive men and women returning to the New York City area (5 boroughs and Long Island). Community Services Coordination for individuals begin immediately upon release and may last for up to six months after release.

Positive Pathways Pilot Program: a program to identify new and existing HIV positive inmates who have not disclosed to, and/or are not in treatment with, DOCCS medical for the purpose of linking to and maintaining medical care and treatment. The program is facility based but continues 6 month post-release to facilitate treatment adherence.

Project START at Re-entry Units: an evidence-based 6-session individual-level risk reduction intervention (2 in-facility, 4 in the community) designed to eliminate or reduce risk behaviors for HIV, STI and hepatitis C after release. All sessions are completed by the same contractor staff.

Additional Community Resources:

Health Resource Portfolios: AIDS Institute supported development of informational packets containing health related materials and condoms to be given to every inmate as they are released from 16 pre-selected DOCCS correctional facilities with the highest release rates.

NYS Condom Program: an AIDS Institute supported initiative with the purpose of increasing the availability of condoms to prevent the transmission of HIV and many other sexually transmitted diseases. Eligible organizations request free male and female condoms, personal lubricant, dental dams and finger cots to then provide to sexually active individuals in their communities.

- Provider network and communication mechanisms - all accomplished through contractor staff. AIDS Institute contract management staff participate in quarterly meetings between DOCCS medical and AIDS Institute administrative staff.
- 3 top recommendations/considerations for the health home pilots to address/incorporate
 - 1) Health Home access training for contractor staff who provide Transitional Planning, Community Services Coordination and Positive Pathways programs to facilitate client enrollment in a Health Homes.
 - 2) Inclusion of Health Home informational materials in Health Resource Portfolios.
 - 3) Coordination of Health Home enrollment with DOCCS staff providing transitional services and/or health care.

Service Definitions:

HIV Prevention Education: Provision of HIV primary and/or secondary education. May be peer or staff delivered.

HIV Training of Peer Educators: Standardized peer education program. Utilizes a curriculum designed for delivery within correctional facility sites. Training consists of multiple education sessions and skills building activities related to presentation and inter-personal negotiation.

HIV Testing: Delivery of on-site anonymous HIV counseling and testing, partner notification assistance and referral.

Client Recruitment: Strategies developed by a service organization to engage members of the target population in care and services.

Transitional Planning: A multi-step, short term service which helps to ensure a continuum of care for HIV-infected pre-release offenders who have disclosed their HIV status within the correctional facility.

Project START: A six session behavioral intervention (two pre-release, four post-release) for high-risk and HIV positive offenders.

Positive Pathways: A unique collaboration between NYSDOH and NYSDOCCS to reduce the stigma associated with being HIV positive in prison, identify HIV positive offenders within the prison system and encourage them to begin treatment in prison, and ensure linkage to treatment and adherence to treatment upon and after release.
