1915c Waiver Providers (OCFS B2H, OMH SED, OPWDD CAH and DOH CAH)

As outlined in the transition in-person training, a number of resource will be provided for 1915c waiver providers to assist you and the children and families you serve to transition to Health Home care management during the transition period of January 1, 2019 through March 31, 2019. Below is a list of each resource and a brief description.

1. **In-Person 1915c Transition to HH Training PPT**
2. **Talking Points for Transitioning 1915c Waiver Providers:** Script for talking to families about the upcoming transition.
3. **Direct Noticing Draft Schedule:** Tentative schedule for messages from the State and Managed Care Plans for recipients and families.
4. **FAQ for Care Managers Regarding transition and services:** Frequently asked questions for CMs about 1915c children's waiver home and community based services.
5. **"Letter to Medicaid Families Jan 1, 2019 CFTSS"** is a copy of the letter that was sent to all Medicaid recipients notifying them of the new State Plan Services of Children and Family Treatment and Support Services (CFTSS) that will begin on January 1, 2019. Any child in Medicaid can be referred to these new services to be determined eligible and current children receiving 1915c HCBS waiver services will convert some of their services if their services align to the new CFTSS (as outlined in guidance). Children currently in a Medicaid Managed Care Plan will have the same information updated in their MCP's member handbook.
6. **The "Letter for HCBS Waiver Families Regarding the Upcoming Changes"** is for current 1915c HCBS waiver providers transitioning to Health Home care management to understand the various changes occurring in January 2019 and share the information and letter with families currently receiving 1915c HCBS waiver services. NYS request that current 1915c HCBS waiver providers share this letter with children and families to ensure they are formal notified of the upcoming changes.
