This General Information System (GIS) message is to notify the Local Districts about the upcoming changes to the over-the-counter drugs covered under NYRx, the Medicaid Pharmacy Program.

NYRx Over-the-Counter (OTC) Drug Changes

As part of the commitment to enhancing patient care, NYRx, the New York State (NYS) Medicaid Pharmacy program, conducted a thorough review of OTC medication utilization and clinical effectiveness. This review addresses a recent amendment to NYS Social Services Law §365-A, found at <u>https://www.nysenate.gov/legislation/laws/SOS/365-A</u>, which took effect **October 1, 2024.**

Effective April 1, 2025, following a 60-day notification for Medicaid members, the items listed below are not covered by NYRx. These changes encourage NYRx members to use safe, effective, and medically necessary Food and Drug Administration (FDA)- approved prescription and non-prescription drugs.

- Cough and Cold Products:
 - o Oxymetazoline
 - o Phenylephrine
- Gastrointestinal Products:
 - o Simethicone
- Anti-hypoglycemics:
 - Glucose Tablets
 - Dermatologicals:
 - \circ Neomycin
 - o Bacitracin
- Multivitamins*:
 - For members aged 21 years and up
 - *This does not apply to prenatal multivitamins.
