AN ACT to amend the limited liability company law, the business corporation law, the partnership law, the education law and the public health law, in relation to authorizing certain licensed health services professionals to form limited liability companies

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision (a) of section 1203 of the limited liability company law, as amended by chapter 554 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Notwithstanding the education law or any other provision of law, 5 one or more professionals each of whom is authorized by law to render a professional service within the state, or one or more professionals, at least one of whom is authorized by law to render a professional service 8 within the state, may form, or cause to be formed, a professional 9 service limited liability company for pecuniary profit under this arti-10 cle for the purpose of rendering the professional service or services as 11 such professionals are authorized to practice. With respect to a profes-12 sional service limited liability company formed to provide medical 13 services as such services are defined in article 131 of the education 14 law, each member of such limited liability company must be licensed 15 pursuant to article 131 of the education law to practice medicine in this state. service limited liability company may engage in any other business or activities as to which a limited liability company may be formed under section two hundred one of this chapter. Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, a professional service limited liability company (i) authorized to practice law may only engage in another profession or business or activities or (ii) which is engaged in a profession or other business or activities other than law may only engage in the practice of law, to the extent not prohibited by any other law of this state or any rule adopted by the appropriate appellate division of the supreme court or the court of appeals.

§ 2. Subdivision (b) of section 1207 of the limited liability company law, as amended by chapter 554 of the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:

Nothing contained in this chapter shall prohibit a corporation licensed pursuant to article forty-three of the insurance law pursuant to its contract with the subscribed from prorationing a medical or dental expenses indemnity allowance among two or 31 more professionals in proportion to the services rendered by each such professional at the request of the subscriber, provided that prior to payment thereof such professionals shall submit both to the corporation licensed pursuant to article forty-three of the insurance law and to the subscriber statements itemizing the services rendered by each such professional and the charges therefor. 38

§ 16. Subdivision 1 of section 2801 of the public health law, as separately amended by chapters 297 and 416 of the laws of 1983, is amended to read as follows:

1. "Hospital" means a facility or institution engaged principally in providing services by or under the supervision of a physician or, in the case of a dental clinic or dental dispensary, of a dentist, for the prevention, diagnosis or treatment of human disease, pain, injury, deformity or physical condition, including, but not limited to, a general hospital, public health center, diagnostic center, treatment center, dental clinic, dental dispensary, rehabilitation center other than a facility used solely for vocational rehabilitation, nursing home, tuberculosis hospital, chronic disease hospital, maternity hospital, lyingin-asylum, out-patient department, out-patient lodge, dispensary and a laboratory or central service facility serving one or more such institutions, but the term hospital shall not include an institution, sanitarium or other facility engaged principally in providing services for 54 the prevention, diagnosis or treatment of mental disability and which is subject to the powers of visitation, examination, inspection and investigation of the department of mental hygiene except for those distinct

parts of such a facility which provide hospital service. The provisions of this article shall not apply to a facility or institution engaged principally in providing services by or under the supervision of the bona fide members and adherents of a recognized religious organization whose teachings include reliance on spiritual means through prayer alone for healing in the practice of the religion of such organization and where services are provided in accordance with those teachings or to a multidisciplinary services practice formed pursuant to subdivision (a) of section twelve hundred three of the limited liability company law, subdivision (b) of section twelve hundred seven of the limited liability company law, subdivision (a) of section thirteen hundred one of the limited liability company law, paragraph (a) of section fifteen hundred three of the business corporation law, subdivision (q) of section 121-1500 of the partnership law, or subdivision (q) of section 121-1502 of the partnership law.

§ 17. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall have become a law; provided, however that sections seven, eight, nine, ten, eleven and twelve of this act shall take effect on the same date and in the same manner as chapter 475 of the laws of 2014, takes effect.
