Are Your Registrations Up to Date?

It's a good idea to periodically review your MURPH registration information. Since it is the start of 2019, take a moment to make sure your information is correct:

- Add new and remove old locations;
- Add or remove EPs who may have joined or left the practice;
- Update EHR information with the 2015 Ed CEHRT information;
- Review and update Alternate contacts; and
- Ensure responses to available registries are accurate.

***Reminder: Registration is only required once. To make updates, please edit the existing registration and do not submit a new registration.**

MURPH Audit Report Card

The Audit Report Card is a self-service utility that provides direct access for Eligible Professionals (EPs), Eligible Hospitals (EHs) and their representatives to Meaningful Use (MU) Public Health On-boarding Status Histories. This new feature allows representatives, EPs or EHs, quick and easy access to a report of their Meaningful Use status history for all of the Public Health registries with which they have registered intent to submit data.

From the MURPH Home Page, users can click on the tab, "Audit Report Card" on the left-hand navigation bar to view the following:

- ✓ A list of registrations for which you are listed as a representative (primary or alternate contact)
- ✓ A list of EPs or EHs associated with each registration
- ✓ The review status for each registration (Approved, Needs Review, Needs Action, Not Submitted, or Deleted)
- ✓ A PDF letter to assist providers in record keeping and audit preparation
- ✓ Current Declaration of Intent, Intent Date, and On-boarding Status History for each EP or EH since their registration with the MURPH System
