



Important Changes to the Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

The Meaningful Use Registration for Public Health (MURPH) System has been updated to support Meaningful Use Public Health Reporting requirements defined in the [Stage 3 and Modifications to Meaningful Use in 2015 Through 2017 Final Rule](#).

Updates at a Glance:

- **90-day EHR Reporting Period for all Eligible Providers in 2015**
- **Registrations accepted for Eligible Providers scheduled to meet Stage 1 in 2015***
- **Cancer case reporting falls under the Specialized Registry Reporting measure for EPs**

*CMS released [FAQ#13409](#) with additional guidance for how Eligible Providers scheduled to meet Stage 1 in 2015 can meet the Public Health Reporting Objective. Eligible Providers scheduled for Stage 1 who submit a test message during their chosen EHR Reporting Period or are submitting production data **do not need to submit a registration in 2015**.
