Healthcare providers (Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and outpatient health clinics)

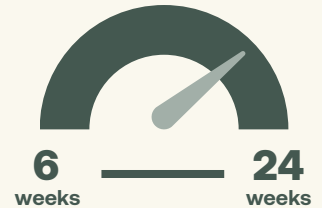


Produce Prescription program voucher redemption sites (farmers markets, mobile markets, farm stands and grocery stores)

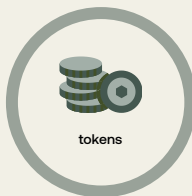
