Collaborative Protocol Change Log V.25.1 Effective 07.01.2025

Collaborative Protocol Change Log from v25.0 to v25.1

The following changes were made in accordance with motions approved at the May 7, 2025 SEMAC and SEMSCO meetings.

(3.0) General Adult and Pediatric Medical Protocols

Hospice Care

- Haloperidol has been removed from the protocol
- Added to medical control considerations:
 - “Olanzapine 10 mg IM[‡] once, or 5 mg SL[‡] once – use caution if midazolam given or anticipated”

(4.0) Trauma

Musculoskeletal Trauma

- Added the word “OR” between Moxifloxacin and Cefazolin to clarify administering one or the other for open fractures with delayed extrication or arrival to definitive care

(5.0) Resources

Oxygen Administration and Airway Management

- Updated wording under EMT related to Supraglottic airway which removes “adult” and allows for placement in both adult and pediatric patients in cardiac arrest.
 - “Supraglottic airway placement[‡] in cardiac arrest patient (as regionally approved)”

[‡] Refers to “If equipped and trained.” This indicates the intervention(s) may be performed if an agency or region chooses to implement the intervention and the practitioner is trained to the standard of the agency or region and has the intervention (medication, equipment, etc) available to them during the course of patient care. These are not required.
