



## TEACHING STUDENTS STOP THE BLEED (STB) IN SCHOOLS

#### Different issue

When discussed at State Trauma Advisory Council (STAC) leadership meeting, the sentiment was that a formal motion from the STAC is not likely to be helpful

Leadership believes the issue is best handled through the legislative branch (STAC is in the executive branch)

What may be more helpful is for STAC to develop a toolkit as a guide for Injury Prevention providers and others to bring STB to schools.
