



Are you thinking about becoming a Living Donor?

We can help pay for:

Travel Transportation, food and lodging related to donating.

Lost Wages Wages that would have been earned if you had not missed work during the donation process.

Dependent Care Money a living donor may spend on care for children, a child with a disability, a dependent adult, or an elderly person during the donation process. Paid care may be needed if the living donor is not able to provide care due to the demands of the process.

Medicines/Medical Care Those associated with the living donation process that are not covered by health insurance.

A Support Person Someone to support and accompany the living donor during the living donation process.
