- An owner's manual, registration card, and model
 number
- Warning labels that say: "This child restraint system conforms to all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards"
- Labels that include:
 - Red and black letters
 - ☑ Child height and weight limits
 - United States phone number and correct grammar
 - Manufacture date and model number

Safe car seats must have key safety features.

- A five-point harness that goes over the child's hips and shoulders
- A chest clip that buckles at the child's armpit level

Search online to see if the car seat is safe.

- Make sure the car seat is certified for use in the United States
- Make sure the car seat is in the original packaging from the manufacturer
- Avoid unfamiliar brands
- Always use the right car seat based upon your child's age and size
