

North-South Breast Cancer Study (NSBCS)



What is the study about?

This study looks at factors that affect breast cancer severity and health after a breast cancer diagnosis. This includes looking at lifestyle, stress, and genetics that may affect breast cancer. The research may help us understand why some women have worse breast cancer outcomes than others.

Who is eligible to participate?

Non-Hispanic Black and non-Hispanic White women, ages 20 to 75, who live in New York State and were diagnosed with breast cancer in 2019 or later.
