

## Reducing Disparities in the Adverse Impact of Cancer in Young Adult Latino Men Study

### What is the study about?

This study looked at any invasive cancer in young adult Latino men. The goal was to provide counseling and support sessions for these individuals. These sessions sought to improve sense of purpose and emotional response for the participants.

### Who is eligible to participate?

Young adult Latino or Hispanic men, ages 18 to 39, who live in New York State. Must have been diagnosed with any invasive cancer between 2020 and 2023.
