





Note: Kotelchuck Index is a calculation based on the number of prenatal care visits received by pregnant women who had a live birth during the reporting year, expressed as a percentage of observed-to-expected number of prenatal visits. Adequate prenatal care is defined as completion of greater than 80% of expected visits.
