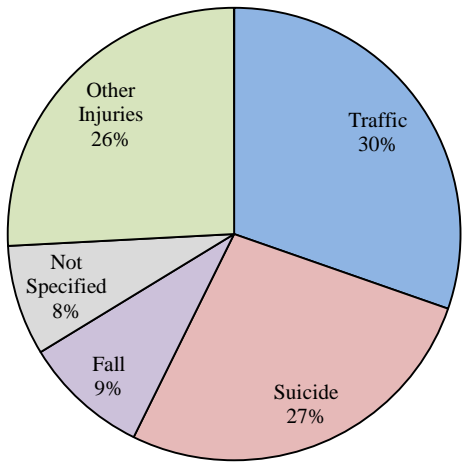


Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations and Emergency Department[†] (ED) Visits

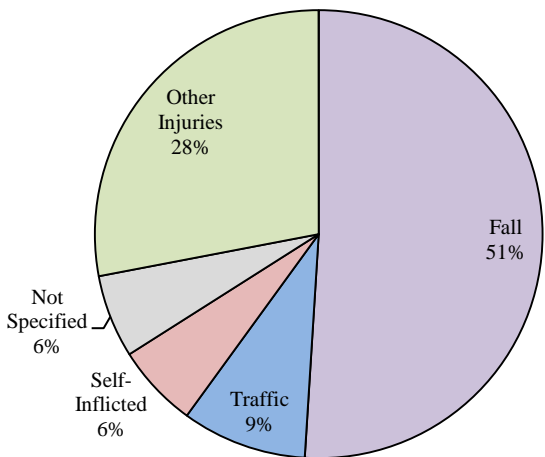
Allegany County, New York Residents, 2005-2007

Deaths



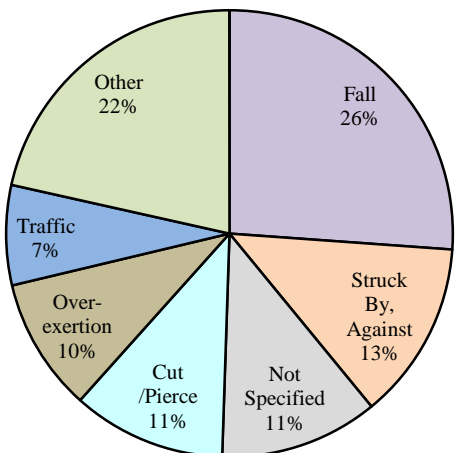
- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause for injury related death for Allegany County residents.
- Annually, 9 Allegany County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Unspecified Persons
 - 3 Occupants

Hospitalizations



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause for injury related hospitalizations for Allegany County residents.
- Annually, 37 Allegany County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 28 Occupants
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians

ED[†] Visits



- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause for injury related outpatient ED[†] visits for Allegany County residents.
- Annually, 378 Allegany County Residents are treated and released from an ED due to traffic related injuries.
 - 310 Occupants
 - 46 Unspecified Persons
 - 12 Motorcyclists
 - 10 Pedestrians

[†]The incidence of ED visits does not include patients that were subsequently admitting into the hospital
