

# Leading Causes of All Injury

## Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits Cattaraugus County Residents, 2012-2014




#### **Deaths**

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Cattaraugus County.
- Annually, 6 Cattaraugus County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.

  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Motorcyclists
  - 0 Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Cattaraugus County.
- Annually, 50 Cattaraugus County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 30 Occupants
  - 9 Motorcyclists
  - 6 Pedestrians
  - \* Unspecified Persons
  - \* Bicyclists



### **Emergency Department (ED)**<sup>†</sup> Visits

- •Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Cattaraugus County.
- Annually, 415 Cattaraugus County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 340 Occupants
  - 22 Pedestrians
  - 22 Unspecified Persons
  - 21 Motorcyclists
  - 8 Bicyclists
