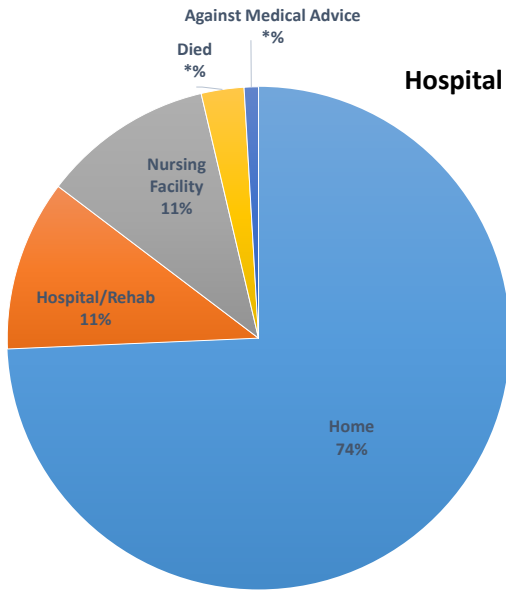


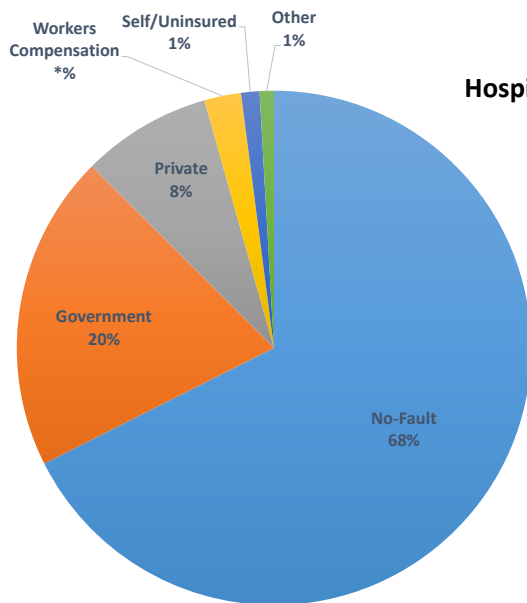
Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury  
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges  
Chautauqua County Residents, 2012-2014



**Hospital Discharge Disposition**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 36 hospitalizations

- 27 Were discharged to their home
- 4 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 4 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- \* Died
- \* Left against medical advice



**Hospitalization Charges**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$1.1 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$720.9 Thousand charged to no-fault insurance
- \$212.4 Thousand charged to public funds
- \$87.0 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$\* Charged to workers compensation
- \$12.3 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
