

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Delaware County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Delaware County.
- Annually, 6 Delaware County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 4 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Delaware County.
- •Annually, 27 Delaware County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 17 Occupants
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Delaware County.
- Annually, 290 Delaware County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 200 Occupants
 - 69 Unspecified Persons
 - 11 Motorcyclists
 - 7 Pedestrians
 - * Bicyclists
