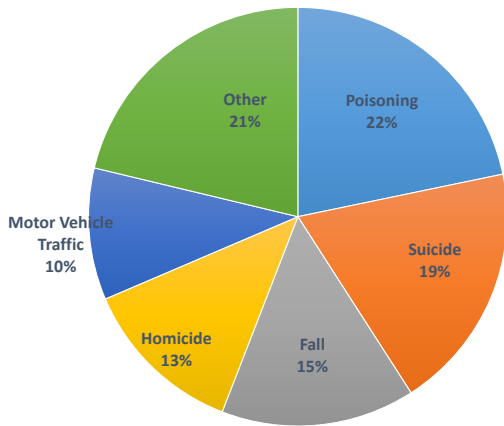
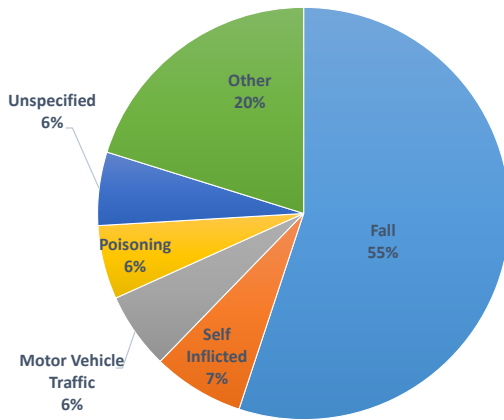


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Erie County Residents, 2012-2014



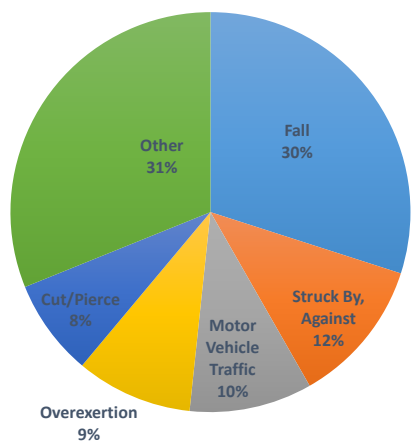
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Erie County.
- Annually, 49 Erie County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 18 Occupants
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 11 Unspecified Persons
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - 2 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Erie County.
- Annually, 446 Erie County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 256 Occupants
 - 81 Pedestrians
 - 67 Motorcyclists
 - 20 Bicyclists
 - 18 Unspecified Persons



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Erie County.
- Annually, 7,190 Erie County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5,995 Occupants
 - 452 Pedestrians
 - 291 Unspecified Persons
 - 194 Motorcyclists
 - 193 Bicyclists
