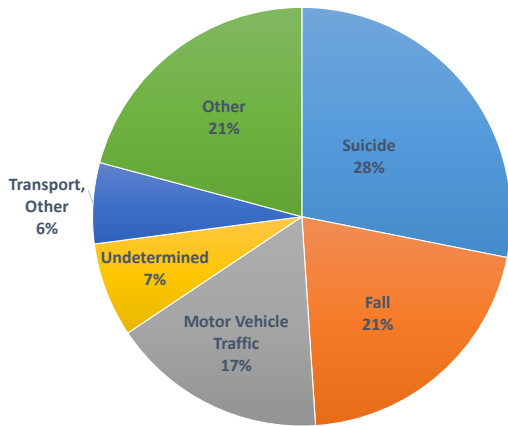
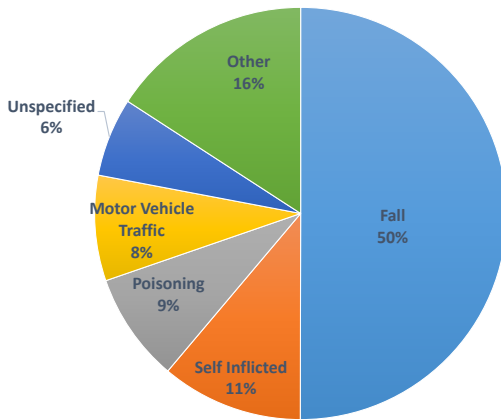


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Herkimer County Residents, 2012-2014



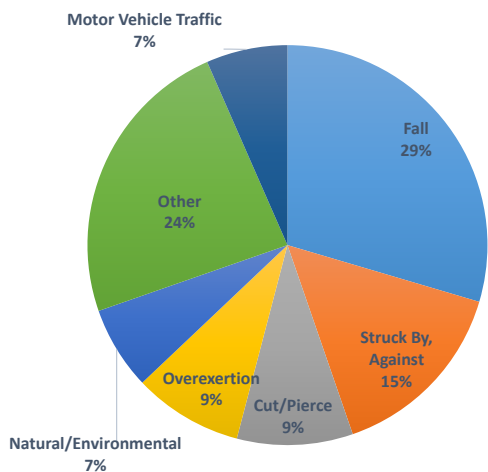
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Herkimer County.
- Annually, 5 Herkimer County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Herkimer County.
- Annually, 47 Herkimer County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 30 Occupants
 - 11 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - 2 Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Herkimer County.
- Annually, 335 Herkimer County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 270 Occupants
 - 27 Unspecified Persons
 - 19 Motorcyclists
 - 13 Pedestrians
 - 3 Bicyclists
