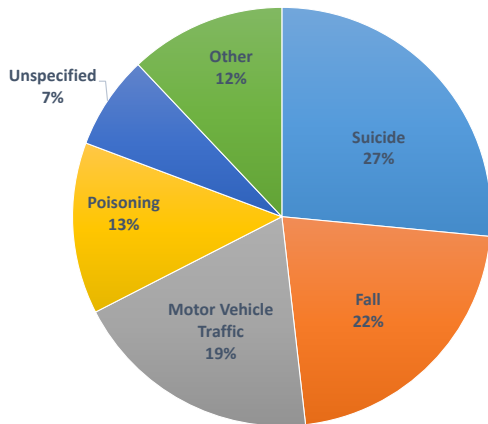
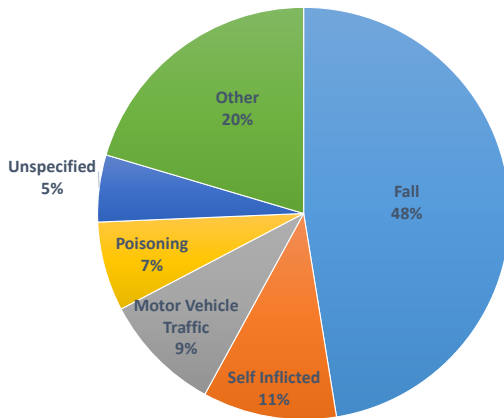


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Livingston County Residents, 2012-2014



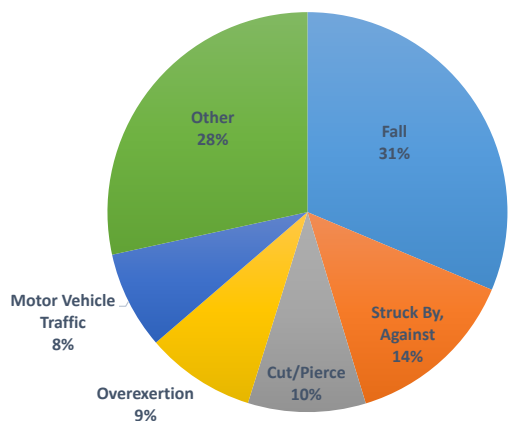
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related death in Livingston County.
- Annually, 5 Livingston County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Livingston County.
- Annually, 41 Livingston County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 30 Occupants
 - 7 Motorcyclists
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Livingston County.
- Annually, 375 Livingston County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 331 Occupants
 - 20 Motorcyclists
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 10 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Bicyclists
