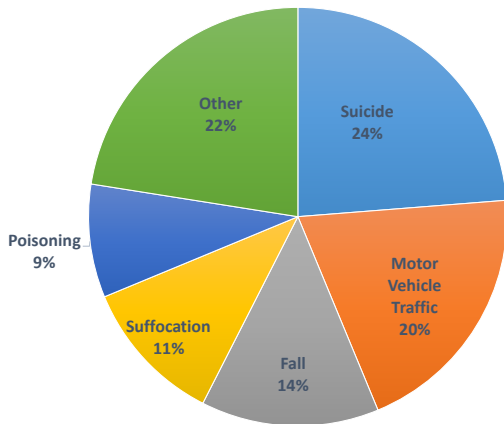
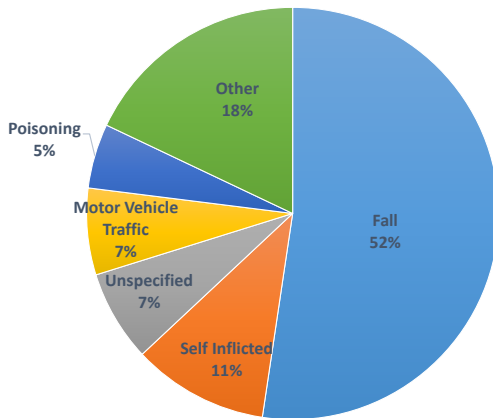


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Montgomery County Residents, 2012-2014



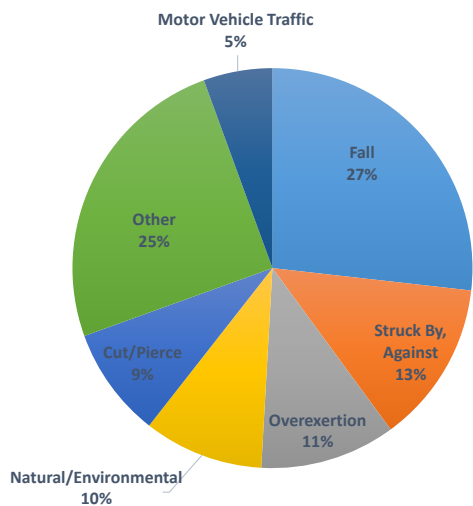
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Montgomery County.
- Annually, 5 Montgomery County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Pedestrians
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Montgomery County.
- Annually, 38 Montgomery County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 24 Occupants
 - 8 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Montgomery County.
- Annually, 408 Montgomery County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 307 Occupants
 - 48 Unspecified Persons
 - 23 Motorcyclists
 - 19 Pedestrians
 - 5 Bicyclists
