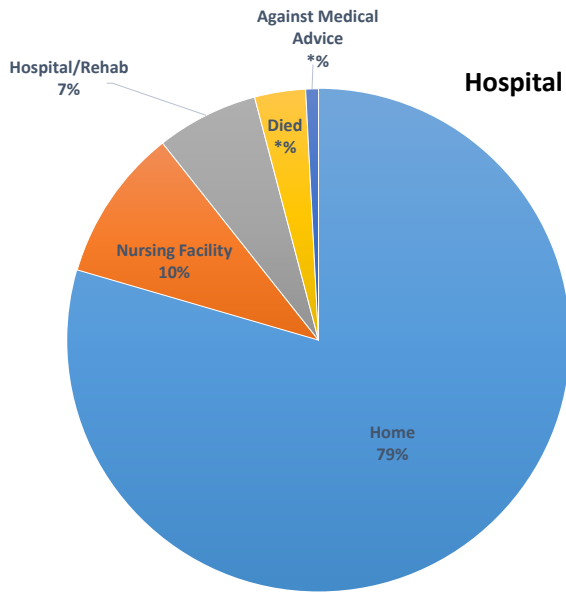


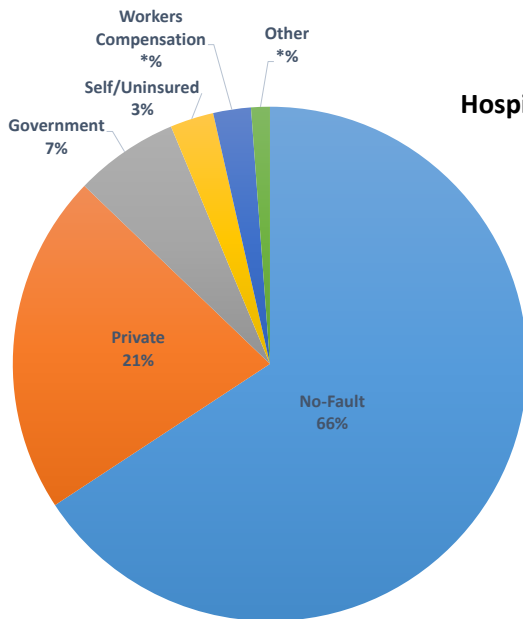
Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury  
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges  
Montgomery County Residents, 2012-2014



**Hospital Discharge Disposition**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 41 hospitalizations

- 32 Were discharged to their home
- 3 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 4 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- \* Died
- \* Left against medical advice



**Hospitalization Charges**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$2.2 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$1.4 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$470.7 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$143.8 Thousand charged to public funds
- \$60.2 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
- \$\* Charged to workers compensation
