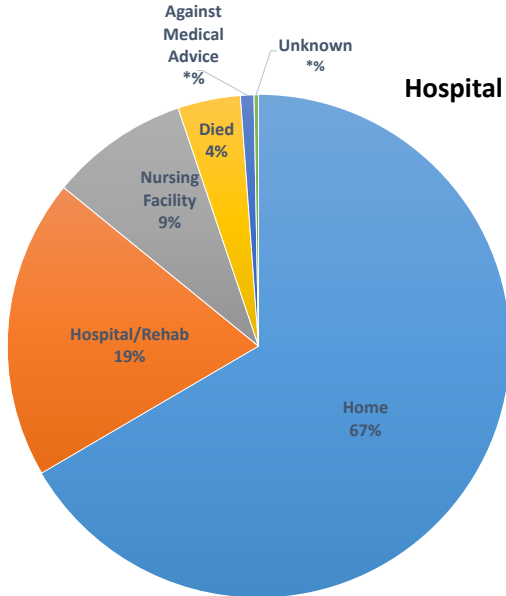


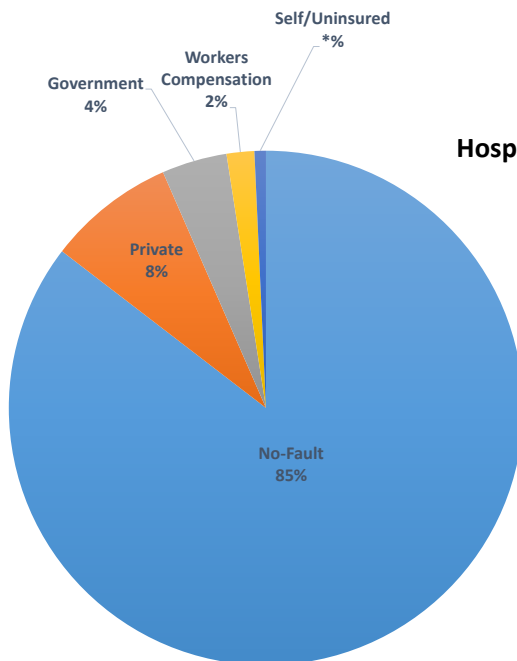
## Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges Niagara County Residents, 2012-2014



**Hospital Discharge Disposition**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 116 hospitalizations

- 77 Were discharged to their home
- 22 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
- 10 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
- 5 Died
- \* Left against medical advice



**Hospitalization Charges**

→ Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$4.8 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:

- \$4.1 Million charged to no-fault insurance
- \$382.4 Thousand charged to private insurance programs
- \$195.5 Thousand charged to public funds
- \$83.1 Thousand charged to workers compensation
- \$\* Charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
