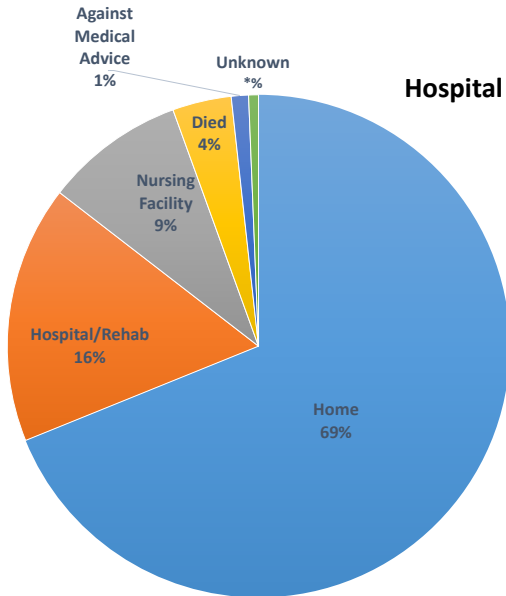
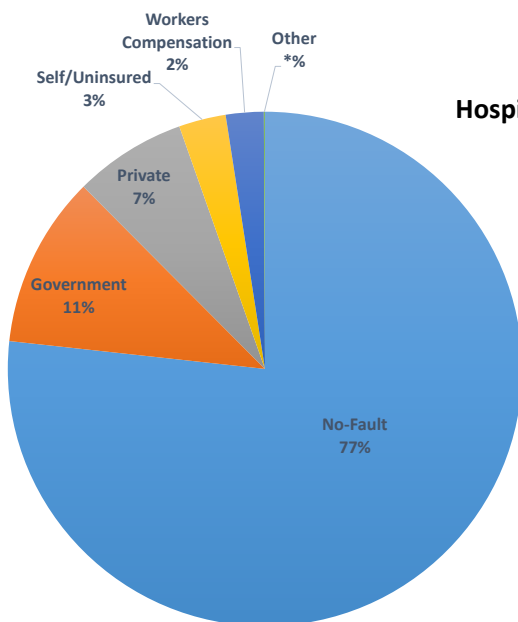


**Motor Vehicle Traffic Injury
Hospital Discharge Disposition and Charges
Onondaga County Residents, 2012-2014**



Hospital Discharge Disposition

- Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of 211 hospitalizations
- 145 Were discharged to their home
 - 35 Were discharged to another hospital or rehabilitation center
 - 19 Were discharged to a skilled nursing facility
 - 8 Died
 - 7 Left against medical advice



Hospitalization Charges

- Annually, traffic injuries resulted in an average of \$15.5 Million in hospitalization charges. Based on the expected principle payer source, there were:
- \$11.9 Million charged to no-fault insurance
 - \$1.7 Million charged to public funds
 - \$1.1 Million charged to private insurance programs
 - \$459.4 Thousand charged to private pay and uninsured individuals
 - \$369.7 Thousand charged to workers compensation
