

Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Rensselaer County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Rensselaer County.
- Annually, 12 Rensselaer County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 5 Unspecified Persons
 - 4 Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Rensselaer County.
- Annually, 94 Rensselaer County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 57 Occupants
 - 20 Motorcyclists
 - 11 Pedestrians
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Rensselaer County.
- Annually, 1,092 Rensselaer County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 904 Occupants
 - 61 Pedestrians
 - 57 Motorcyclists
 - 48 Unspecified Persons
 - 13 Bicyclists
