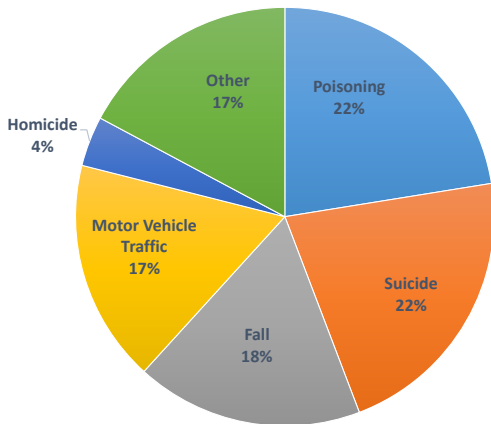
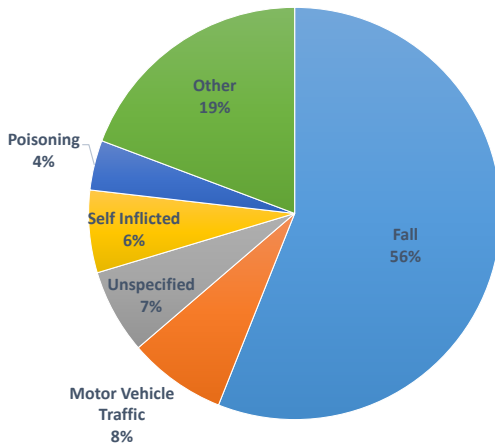

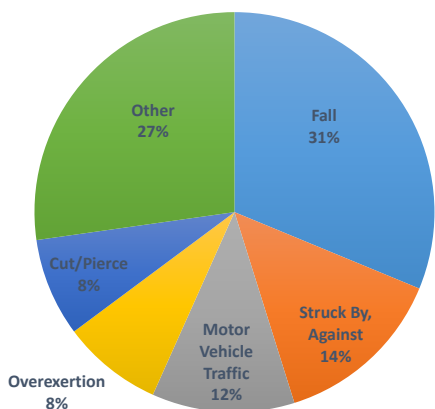
### Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related death in Rockland County.
- Annually, 16 Rockland County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
  - 3 Occupants
  - 4 Pedestrians
  - 6 Unspecified Persons
  - 4 Motorcyclists
  - \* Bicyclists



### Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Rockland County.
- Annually, 162 Rockland County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
  - 95 Occupants
  - 31 Pedestrians
  - 24 Motorcyclists
  - 8 Unspecified Persons
  - 3 Bicyclists



### Emergency Department (ED)<sup>†</sup> Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Rockland County.
- Annually, 2,354 Rockland County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
  - 2,051 Occupants
  - 146 Pedestrians
  - 57 Unspecified Persons
  - 56 Motorcyclists
  - 20 Bicyclists
