

Leading Causes of All Injury

Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Saratoga County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Saratoga County.
- Annually, 17 Saratoga County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 6 Occupants
 - 5 Unspecified Persons
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - 3 Motorcyclists
 - * Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Saratoga County.
- Annually, 134 Saratoga County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 93 Occupants
 - 28 Motorcyclists
 - 8 Pedestrians
 - 4 Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Saratoga County.
- Annually, 1,035 Saratoga County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 863 Occupants
 - 62 Motorcyclists
 - 47 Unspecified Persons
 - 42 Pedestrians
 - 12 Bicyclists
