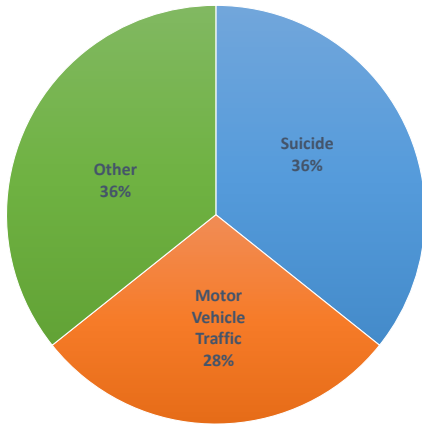
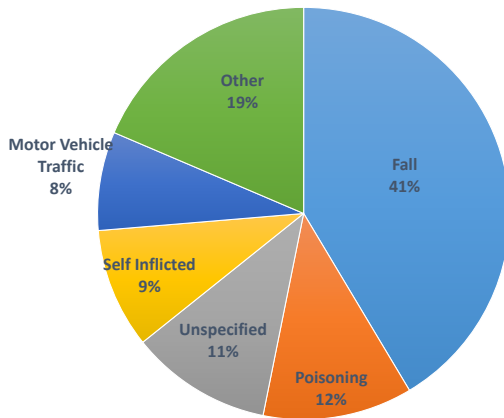


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Schoharie County Residents, 2012-2014



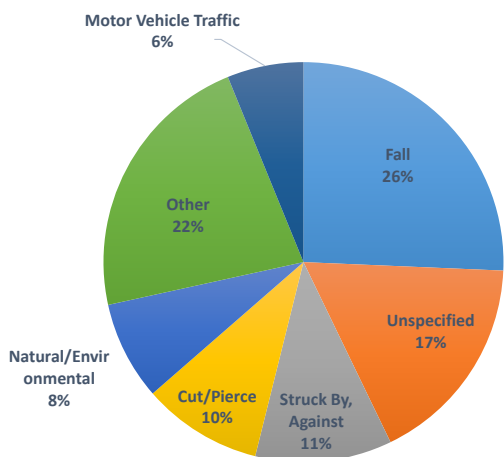
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Schoharie County.
- Annually, 4 Schoharie County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2 Occupants
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists
 - 0 Pedestrians



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Schoharie County.
- Annually, 20 Schoharie County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 15 Occupants
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - 0 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Schoharie County.
- Annually, 210 Schoharie County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 118 Occupants
 - 77 Unspecified Persons
 - 10 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Pedestrians
 - * Bicyclists
