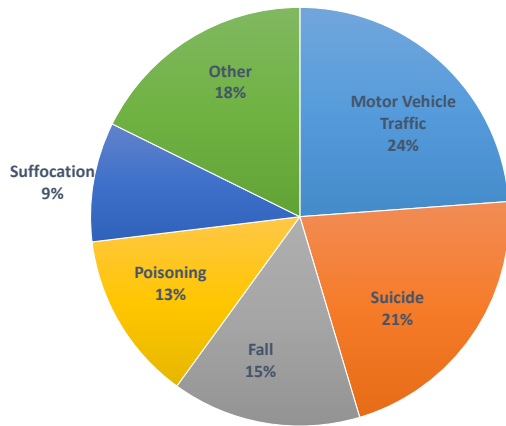
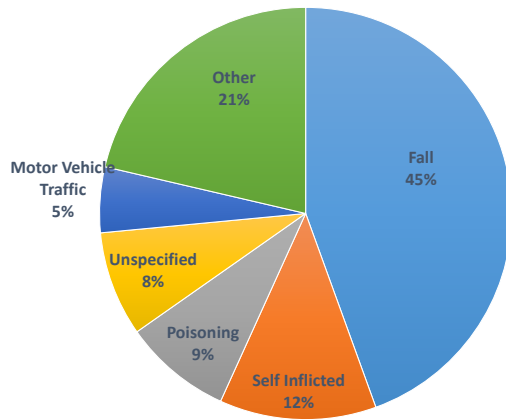


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits St. Lawrence County Residents, 2012-2014



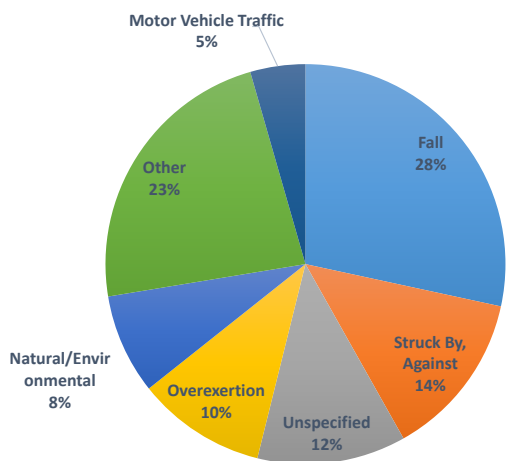
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the leading cause of injury related death in St. Lawrence County.
- Annually, 10 St. Lawrence County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 7 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Bicyclists
 - 0 Motorcyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in St. Lawrence County.
- Annually, 40 St. Lawrence County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 27 Occupants
 - 8 Motorcyclists
 - 3 Unspecified Persons
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - 0 Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in St. Lawrence County.
- Annually, 645 St. Lawrence County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 499 Occupants
 - 70 Unspecified Persons
 - 37 Motorcyclists
 - 23 Pedestrians
 - 8 Bicyclists
