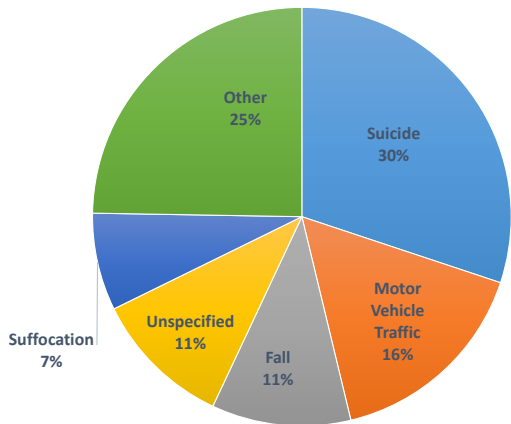
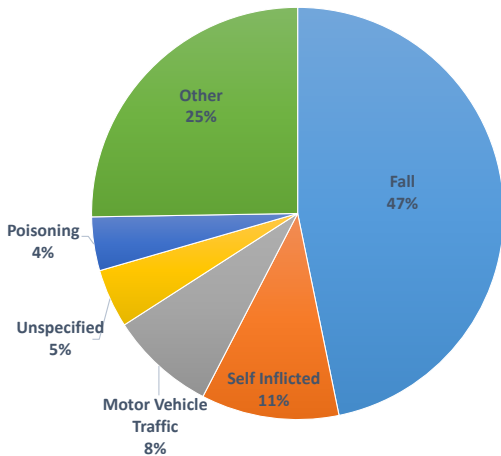


Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits Washington County Residents, 2012-2014



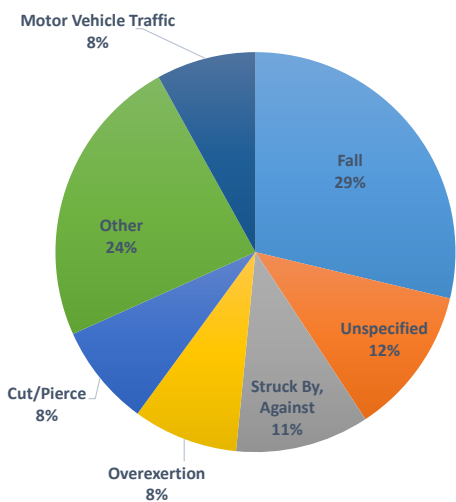
Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Washington County.
- Annually, 5 Washington County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - 2 Unspecified Persons
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Washington County.
- Annually, 47 Washington County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 34 Occupants
 - 10 Motorcyclists
 - 2 Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Washington County.
- Annually, 390 Washington County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 322 Occupants
 - 26 Unspecified Persons
 - 26 Motorcyclists
 - 12 Pedestrians
 - 5 Bicyclists
