

Leading Causes of All Injury Deaths, Hospitalizations, and Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

Wyoming County Residents, 2012-2014




Deaths

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the second leading cause of injury related death in Wyoming County.
- Annually, 4 Wyoming County Residents die due to traffic related injuries.
 - * Occupants
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Motorcyclists
 - 0 Bicyclists



Hospitalizations

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are the third leading cause of injury related hospitalizations in Wyoming County.
- Annually, 22 Wyoming County Residents are hospitalized due to traffic related injuries.
 - 14 Occupants
 - 4 Motorcyclists
 - * Pedestrians
 - * Unspecified Persons
 - * Bicyclists



Emergency Department (ED)[†] Visits

- Motor Vehicle Traffic Injuries are a leading cause of injury related emergency department visits in Wyoming County.
- Annually, 279 Wyoming County Residents are treated and released from an emergency department due to traffic related injuries.
 - 236 Occupants
 - 19 Unspecified Persons
 - 12 Motorcyclists
 - 9 Pedestrians
 - * Bicyclists
