Operating System

- Windows 11, Windows 10
- Apple MacOS current version

Internet

- High-speed internet connection
- Internet Browsers (Refer to the Procedure to Turn off AutoFill/AutoComplete settings)
 - Microsoft Edge
 - Google Chrome current version
 - Safari for MacOS
- Browser Settings
 - TLS 1.2 encryption enabled
 - Java scripting enabled (typically medium-low security setting)
 - Cookies accepted
 - Depending on your facility's network security settings, you may also need to add the following website addresses to your browser's *Trusted Sites* list:

Viewing and Printing Documents

- **Adobe Acrobat Reader**, version 2020 or newer. This is necessary to view/print forms and reports.
 - Acrobat PDF Reader must be from Adobe for full compatibility with DAVE. Other PDF viewers are not fully compatible with DAVE/EDRS forms and certificates.
 - A browser should not be used as the default viewer for printing burial permits or death certificates.
- **Printer**
 - When printing certificates and forms from DAVE/EDRS, the printer settings must be set to **Fit, Fit to Page** or **Shrink Oversized Pages** so that the entire form will print.

Mobile Devices: Full compatibility between HCS/DAVE and mobile devices (tablets and smart phones) is not guaranteed. The EDRS *Cause of Death* page may not be fully visible with some smart phones.
